Big Give report 2023

Background

The 12th Big Give Christmas Appeal was held during December 2023.

The event is Fifeshire Foundation's annual charity appeal where we collect donations, and then gift parcels to whanau in need in our community facing hardship at a difficult time of year.

Highlights

This year we received a large number of worthy nominations from agencies and gift parcels were allocated to over 300 families.

Donations were received from far and wide, from schools, community groups, local businesses and individuals.

Parcels focused on Christmas treats, family activities, vouchers and gifts.

By the numbers

305 parcels gifted to families in hardship, reaching **1314** individuals including **897** children

We gifted **1086** vouchers for activities, petrol, food, treats, **209** volunteer hours, **74** different nominators from **36** agencies/schools nominating families for a parcel.

The estimated value of donations and gifts is around \$50,000 including sponsorship, cash donations, gifts, donated or discounted vouchers and activities, treats and toys.


